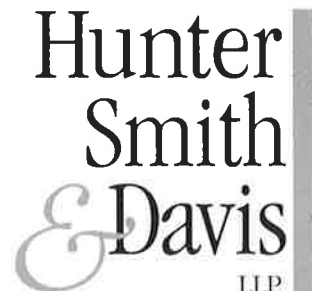

Who May Enter?

Kingsport Art Guild (KAG) membership is NOT required. Artists 14 years or older may enter; artists 14-19 years old are eligible for student awards.

*Each work eligible for only one placement award. Placing works will be considered for the "Celebrate Kingsport," presentation**, and people's choice awards.

***Most professional or effective presentation of work.

Requirements

- Up to two original works. Original means the work is designed solely by the artist or based on the artist's own photograph. Copies of another's work from any medium, including photography, are ineligible.
- All media eligible except glass, photography, and computer-generated art.
- Work must have been completed since July 1, 2008, and must not have appeared in a previous FunFest Show.
- 2D and 3D wall art must be no more than 52"h x 52"w and must not exceed 3" in depth. All work must be wired to hang; no saw-tooth or clip hangers or unframes. All work (except student work) must be framed or have a gallery wrap (at least 1 1/2" and fully painted with no visible staples). Artists may use glass at their own risk.
- Student canvases may be unframed and lack a gallery wrap; other 2D student work must be matted.
- Freestanding 3D art must be no more than 24"h x 18"w x 18"d and must weigh no more than 30 pounds. The artist must provide his or her own pedestal (sturdy and in excellent condition) at drop-off. No suspended work or installations.
- All work must be titled and must hang for the duration of the show. No exceptions.

Responsibility

Reasonable care and protection will be provided for all works; however, the Renaissance Center, Kingsport Art Guild, Kingsport Theater Guild, Kingsport FunFest, the City of Kingsport, and *Model City Art Show* and *A Taste for the Unusual* sponsors are not responsible for any loss or damage. Each artist must sign the release agreement on the entry form.

Entry

- **If you register before May 28, 2010**, your work could be considered for inclusion in *Model City Art Show* promotional materials. Just enclose a CD with your registration that contains professional-quality high-resolution PC-compatible JPEG images of the work(s) you submitted. JPEGs should be at least 1200 but no more than 1800 pixels on their longest side. Submitting a CD implies your permission to use images of your work for promotional purposes. - All entries must be **postmarked by June 11, 2010**.
- Send the completed, signed entry form with a check for \$10 (one work) or \$15 (two works) payable to "Kingsport Art Guild," and CD (early reg. only) to:
